Accessing Degree Works

- x Log into the myLewis portal at myLewis.lewisu.edu.
- x Once logged in, click on the Resources tab.
- x Click on the icon for Degree Works.

A Degree Works audit is a review of past, current, and planned coursework that provides information on complete outstanding catalog requirements necessary to complete a degree/major/minor/concentration. The audit is divided into requirements such as Degree, General Education, Major Requirements, Minor Requirements, and Concentration requirements. The audit is essentially a checklist of requirements for a degree through Lewis University. Completed and progress classes are used to fill spots within the audit showing which requirements have been completed, which are in progress, and classes/requirements still remain.
